Remind yourself that \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ While many people do love reading, many others do not. And that's okay.
\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ List it in your planner or daily to-do list.
\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ Consider your personal preferences for location, temperature, lighting, background noise (or silence), snacks, caffeinated beverages, writing utensils, etc.
\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ Don't try to struggle through a 3-hour block of constant reading. Set a timer for, say, 20 to 30 minutes of reading, and then take a 5- or 10-minute break for a walk, stretch, and quitug.
